IS THE WALK-IN CLINIC RIGHT FOR YOU?

Our Walk-In Clinic provides problem-focused, same-day services for non-life-threatening medical conditions when access to your primary care provider is not available.

Be aware that the Walk-in Clinic is not an Emergency Room or Urgent Care Center, and is not able to provide emergency services.

We can help with a temporary refill (typically 30 days) of many kinds of routine medications – with the general exception of narcotics and similarly controlled medications – while you await your Primary Care appointment. Ongoing treatment of chronic conditions should be managed through a Primary Care office.

The Walk-In Clinic does not provide specialty services. If you have a condition that warrants evaluation or treatment by a specialist (such as an ophthalmologist, psychiatrist, surgeon, dermatologist), or if you need specialized diagnostic testing (such as an MRI), direct contact with the appropriate specialist is generally recommended.

Our goal is to support continuity of care by working with, not as a substitute for, your primary care provider.

Patients are seen in the order of arrival. To avoid waiting unnecessarily for services that may not be available at our clinic, you can ask for a focused screening to help answer whether the Walk-In Clinic is appropriate for your need.

EMERGENCY

**CALL 911 OR GO TO THE
EMERGENCY ROOM**

For potentially life-threatening or urgent medical conditions.

- Potential heart-related conditions
- Significant breathing difficulties
- Trauma beyond minor musculoskeletal injuries
- Multiple traumatic injuries
- Head or spine injury
- Significant or ongoing blood loss
- Abdominal pain that is more than minor
- Neurologic symptoms, possible stroke, weakness, severe headache
- Disorientation, marked debilitation, or signs of serious systemic illness
- Severe allergic reactions or anaphylaxis
- Complications of pregnancy

For same-day access when your primary care provider is not available.

- ✓ Minor cuts, wounds, injuries
- ✓ Sprains and strains

- ✓ Uncomplicated vomiting or diarrhea
- ✓ Urinary symptoms
- ✓ School-related sport physicals
- ✓ Temporary refills of routine medications, EXCEPT opioids or benzodiazepines
- ✓ Initial assessment for minor work injury
